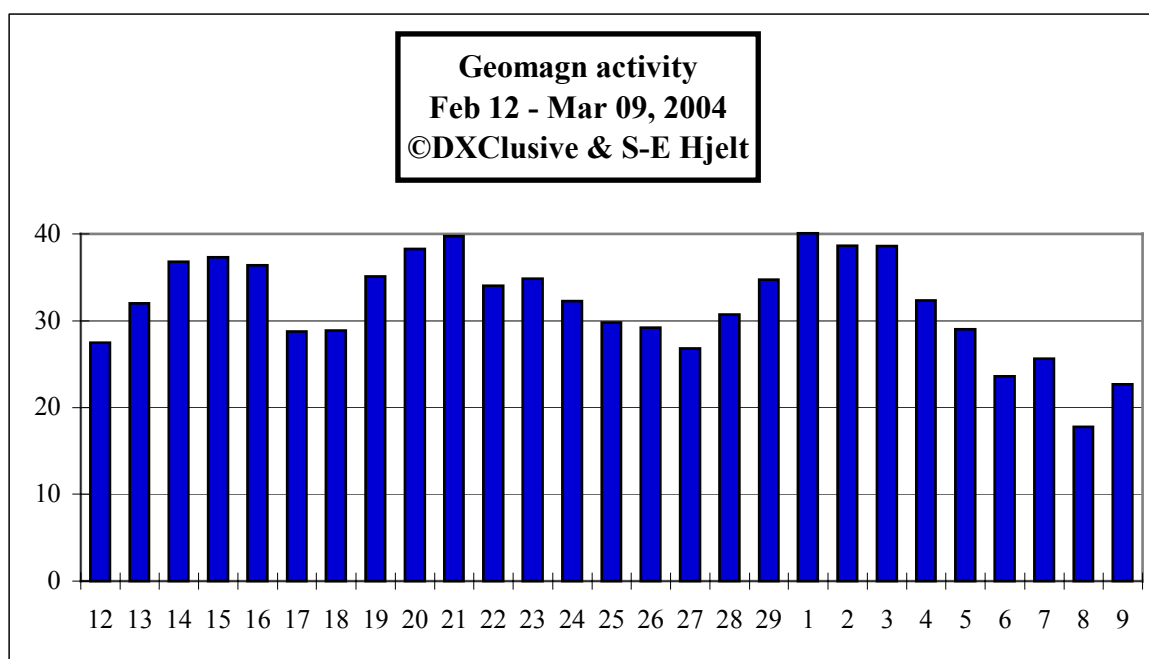

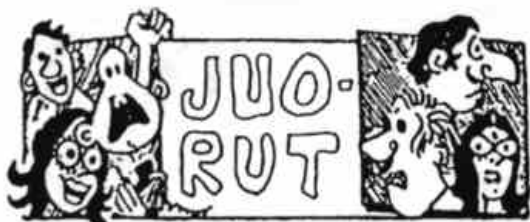

CZECH REPUBLIC

270 "Today I have received after 20 days a reply directly from the Topolná transmitter site in the Czech Rep. They are broadcasting on 270 with 650 kW. The envelope contains a QSL-card, personal letter and an old pennant from the communist era showing 272 kHz, 1500 kW. All custom made, not from Czech Radio. Important changes on mediumwaves from 1 February 2004:

All transmitters of CRO 6 on 1071, 1233 and 1287 kHz will cease operations on 31 January 2004. Programme CRO 6 will be rescheduled, new on-air time will be 18:00 - 24:00 LT (1700 - 2300 UTC). The program will be relayed on CRO 2 transmitters on 639, 954 and 1332 kHz. More transmitters to cease operation on 31 January 2004:

558 kHz - Tachov/Právo

864 kHz - Strakonice/Radomysl

981 kHz - Jihlava/Vetrník

With Tachov 558 kHz closing down it is now the last chance to catch, report and verify the last regional programme from the Czech

Republic on medium waves. Tachov relays regional program of Studio Plzen (Pilsen) - 24 h. Power is not too big - 1 kW. Despite the plans to close down the LW transmitter Topolná 270 kHz too, the transmitter seems to survive again and stays on the air after 1 February. (Karel Honzik via MWDX 18.1.2004) MV Eko

DENMARK

World Music Radio is currently building a new studio and offices. A new 10kw shortwave transmitter is expected later this month. WMR's official relaunch is planned for February. Frequencies will be 5815 and 15810. (Dave Harries, Bristol, Hard Core DX) Contact

FRANCE

RMC Info was to start broadcasting yesterday, 5 Jan, in Nancy on 1485 and in Strasbourg and Mulhouse on 1584 kHz. So far no signal can be heard. Sources at the station say there will be further delays. The target date now mentioned is early February. Other sources (who insist on remaining anonymous) say RMC Info are re-considering their plan to broadcast on MW altogether. They were expecting DRM receivers to spread very quickly but so far there are none on the market. So the station may well hand back its license and keep applying for FM outlets in these cities. Although they were not awarded a license last year when the CSA picked the stations that would be allowed to broadcast on MW, Littoral AM are planning to go on they air sometime this spring on a 9 month temporary license, the

same kind of license Ciel AM used in Paris a couple of years ago. So far the license has not been issued but Littoral AM are very likely to get it, since the regulatory body is very keen to see some stations go on the air at last. With several of the planned stations likely to hand back their licenses due to the generally negative response in the public to the use of the MW band, the CSA want to get the thing going, and the sooner the better, as a kind of real-scale feasibility test, just like Ciel AM was...

Littoral AM have started fitting out their studio and recording programmes, they are also trying to find the necessary money to get the project under way. So far they have collected some 50 000 euros out of the 300 000 needed for the station. They will broadcast from the small town of Lamballe with 10 kW on 936 kHz. The aerial will be a 65 metre-high single mast. The coverage area will be most of French Brittany but the station should also be heard well in the south-west of the UK, roughly speaking west of the Isle of Wight and of course in the Channel Islands. GERMANY

531 The DRM test project "531 digital" was concluded on Dec 31, 2003, and the transmitter at Burg was switched off. The 531 channel will be put on tender. A project office responsible for the promotion of digital broadcasting states that Europe 1 intends to start DRM transmissions (of a German program, not the French one aired via 183) on Burg 261 later this year. 702 Jülich and 855 Nordkirchen have been put on tender. These frequencies were once allocated to VIVA Radio, a joint venture of the VIVA TV company with Radio NRW, the content supplier of the local stations in Nord-rhein-Westfalen. This project never materialized, and obviously the licence was quietly returned by both companies in the meantime (I think a withdrawal would have come to our attention). The transmitters (both 5 kW) exist, 855 was already heard with a test tone while 702 was noted testing with nonstop music and Megaradio audio. (Kai Ludwig, 2 Jan 2004)

 ARD-Nachtexpress is one of the three overnight programmes produced on a rota scheme and distributed through circuits leased anyway and otherwise used for feeds. The other ones are ARD-Nachtkonzert, aired by all culture / classical music programs, and ARD-Popnacht.

The latter one is already dead meanwhile, used only by HR and SR anymore.

IRELAND

1278 RTÉ's 2FM medium wave transmitter situated at Beaumont in north Dublin ceased transmission on Monday, 15th December. Speaking to Radiowaves News today, an RTÉ spokesman said that research indicates that 2FM listeners prefer the superior sound quality on FM. "The number of people actually tuned to 1278 kHz has declined considerably over the years," he said. "However, transmission of 2FM on medium wave will continue for the foreseeable future from our Athlone transmitter on 612 kHz."

THE NETHERLANDS

Agreement reached on future use of Lopik
Here in the Netherlands, an agreement has been reached between the local councils of IJsselstein, Lopik and Montfoort, the Ministry of Economic Affairs, the Province of Utrecht

and transmitter operator Nozema which should bring an end to interference suffered by nearby homes from the mediumwave transmitters at Lopik. The key points are as follows:

1. The total permitted power output will be reduced from the current 240 kW (2 x 120 kW) to 100 kW, with a reserve of 40 kW.
2. The mast at the northern end of the site closest to IJsselstein will be dismantled within 12 months from the signing of the agreement.
3. Transmissions on the higher mediumwave frequencies such as 1008 and 1395 kHz, which require more power to cover the same area, will no longer be made, even as backups.
4. In the long term, the transmitter site could be moved to a platform on the Markermeer polder. However, this won't be necessary if mediumwave goes digital.

The plan means that the transmitter power of Arrow Classic Rock on 675 kHz will be reduced from the present 120 kW to 100 kW, but the big loser is Quality Radio bv, which holds six mediumwave licences including the one for 1395 kHz currently leased to Radio 10 Gold. "We have not even been informed, let alone consulted," said a Quality Radio spokesman.

The licence for 1395 kHz officially permits the use of up to 120 kW from Lopik, but a lower power transmitter at Trintelhaven is currently used, significantly reducing the coverage area. According to Quality Radio, it appears to be wrongly assumed by a number of parties, such as the municipality of IJsselstein and the province of Utrecht, that the current situation is satisfactory. It means that Arrow Classic Rock, which was involved in the consultations although it officially doesn't have a terrestrial licence, gets to use Lopik, leaving Quality Radio - which has a valid licence for 1395 kHz - empty handed. Quality Radio says it will block the signing of the agreement as long as all the possibilities for 1395 AM from Lopik have not been investigated fully. The broadcaster says that in principle it's

prepared to keep the power level as low as possible to ensure that the nuisance to nearby homes is restricted to an acceptable level. (Media News of Radio Netherlands)

Update: Arrow Classic Rock has issued a statement refuting suggestions on some media Web sites that the power reduction to 100 kW means it will have less than 100% coverage of the country. In fact, the reduction in signal strength is unlikely to be noticed by anyone within the Dutch borders, though some listeners further away might notice a small difference. With this in fact, the "Pasaje KL" seems to have been named after the transmitter site of YSKL.
