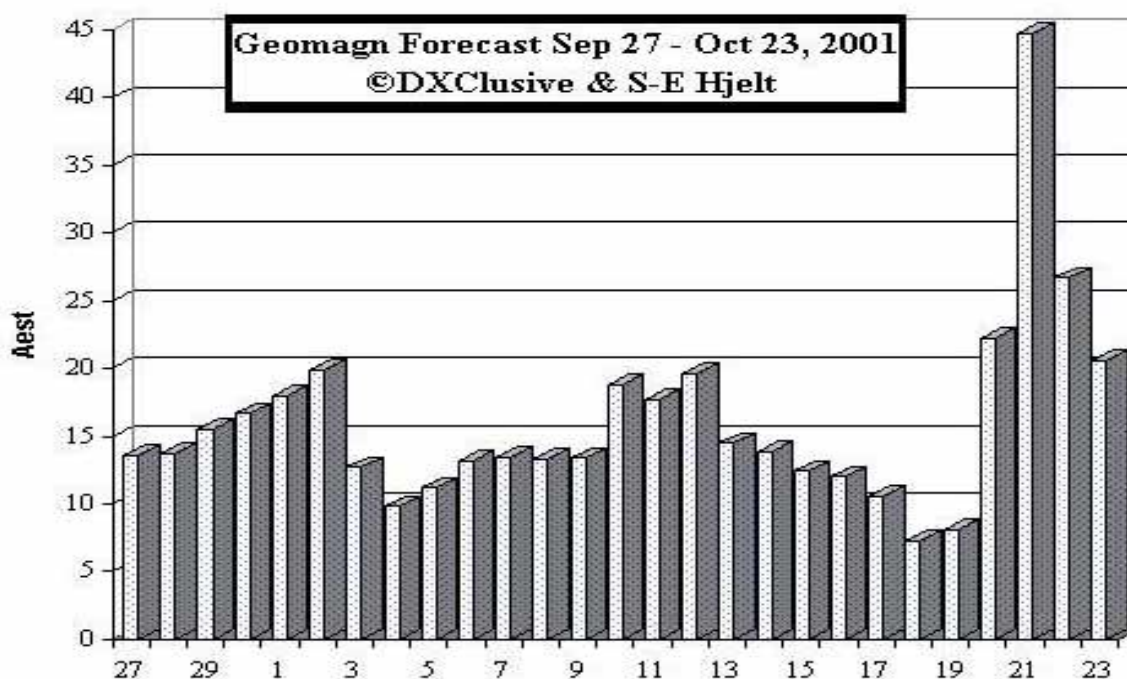

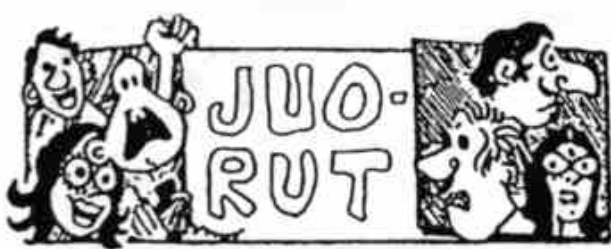

4777.1 RRI Jakarta, 1940, noted reactivated after a long absence. Fair signal though some audio distortion noted. Program was a male host taking phone calls. (Paul Ormandy-NZL, Aug 22)

assistance. All freqs appear to be via Cimanggis (Jakarta) 250 kW. Some language sces seem to disappear occasionally for days or weeks, with txs remaining on air with open carrier at the relevant times.

JORDAN

6985.05 [spur see Below] R Jordan was heard here with Arabic nx at 1800 and a clear ID after the nx at 1823, then into mx. After that I checked 9830, which was //, but much stronger. Suddenly thereafter 6985 was no longer audible, but 9830 remained on the air. Wonder what this 6985.05 really is. I guess R Jordan doesn't have the habit of txing on out-of-band freqs. (Mäkeläinen-FIN, Aug 28)

Jordan produces spurious signals of the 7155 fundamental, as reported in past months/years by a lot of DXers.

7155 1600-1900 11-14,46S AKA 500 kW 245 degra JOR JRT

So try also symmetrical 7155 + 170 kHz 7325, on the upper side. And check in this autumn, whether the signal appears just before 1600 UT, and drops out at around 1900 UT. (WB)

M. Mäkeläinen isn't the only one confused by JOR 6985. Jordan Radio is currently using 7155 at 1700-1830. This freq has its own txion for the first hour and then //s 9830 until close down with different ID (to 9830). I recently heard 6985 still on air past 1830 carrying the same progr as heard on 9830. There was a carrier only - no audio - on 7155. When the carrier went off, 6985 also disappeared! JOR appears to have reduced txion time on 11960 and is heard closing c0710 - one hour earlier than previously. This is co-channel with RDP Lisbon weekdays but clear Sat/Sun. MALAYSIA

In Kota Kinabalu, KK, capital city of the Malay state of Sabah on the northern tip of the island of Borneo, these observations were made from the 11th floor of a modern hotel building. In K-L on the Malay peninsula, these observations were made from the 17th floor of a modern apartment building. The radio receiver in use at all times was the compact but very useful Grundig 700 Satellit with a whip antenna only. Listening conditions in Kota Kinabalu were particularly good on MW.

576 Radio Malaysia Sarawak Miri, 20 kW 2133 UTC with Sarawak ID, good signal, [heard from] KK.

594 Tutong Brunei 500 kW 2130 UTC ID as "Radio Brunei di nasional", KK.

648 Limbang Sarawak 20 kW, // to 576 and stronger signal, KK.

675 Serasa Brunei 200 kW strong signal 2245 ID as "Inilah Radio Brunei", Brunei heard here, not Sabah, KK.

711 South Hanching Brunei 20 kW, 2300 relay 675 lower signal, KK.

999 RRI Indonesia 150 kW, only st heard on the MW band at this time, 4:00 am LT, 2000 UTC, KK.

1197 Malay language programming, Kudat Sabah listed, this may have been the only Sabah MW st I heard, KK.

4845 Radio Malaysia Kajang 100 kW Tamil service, heard many times, always a strong signal, KK & KL.

4895 Radio Malaysia Sarawak Kuching 2140 UT s-on routine beginning with tone signal, tuning signal, anthem, jingle, opening annt; good signal on clear channel, // KK.

5030 Kuching Sarawak 10 kW 2140 // 4895, KK.

5065 9MB6 Penang, Malay navy with Morse ID 1005 UTC, KL.

6050 Sibu Sarawak 10 kw 2140 // 4895, KK. (Adrian M. Peterson, DX Editor, AWR, August, K-L or KK-MLA, DXLD)

LAOS

6130 Lao Nat R, full data letter with stn stamp, V/s Ms. Malivarn, English Section, LNR for an April 17th 2000 English report. After having no luck with follow-ups I asked a former colleague of mine, a Stuck Hole Engineer working for Canadian Hunter in NoLaos to have one of the local kids deliver the report. Boom, my letter was carried over to Laos July 8th, delivered July 24th and returned today August 13th. She sent me a beautiful Laotian Red Border Guard neck scarf, a long friendly letter and requested further correspondence with me. VIETNAM

Here is the current observed schedule for VOV-4 (minority language sce), modified at the beginning of July with the addition of a new language, Komor. I have not been able to monitor daytime and early evening usage of 690 and 1090v recently, so the relevant details for

those freqs are assumed. Languages in the first two groups below are broadcast in 30-minute blocks.

Bahnar [Bana, Ba Na] / Gia Rai [Giarai, Jarai, Jra] / Kohor [Koho, K'Hor]: 2200-2300, 2330-2400, 0330-0500, 0930-1100 on 690 & 7210.

Edeh [Ede, E De, Rade] / Sedang [Xedang, Xe Dang]: 2200-2300, 0400-0500, 0930-1030 on 1090v & 6020.

H'mong [Hmong, Ho Mong]: 2200-2300, 0500-0600, 1200-1330 on 5035v & 6165.

Khmer [Kho Me]: 2200-2245, 0415-0500, 1300-1345 on 873.

Tx locations: 5035v & 6165 Hanoi area; 873 Thoi Long, Can Tho Province 500 kW; 690 & 1090v Buon Me Thuot, Dak Lak Province.

Location of 6020 and 7210 is unknown, but almost certainly in the southern half of Vietnam. Buon Me Thuot might be a possibility. Both freqs, and especially 7210, are subject to quite frequent breaks, and usually produce symmetrical spurs approx. +/- 14 kHz.

At other times, 690 and 7210 carry VOV-1 2200-1600, 1090v and 6020 carry VOV-2 2200-1600, and 873 carries VOV-3 (mostly music) and some special programming for the Mekong Delta region 2200-1700.

On Aug 16, the President Fernando De la Rúa blasted press reports of Argentina closing its Antarctic bases as false. This was also denied officially also by the Argentine Chancellor Mr. Adalberto Rodriguez Giavarini and the secretary of Military Affairs of the Ministry of Defense, Mr. Angel Tello.

Of course, all these they are the official versions, we not know with certitude that will happen in the future to LRA36, but while, we will continue listening its signal on 15476. The change of the Argentine endowment will be asusual, in Dec 2001, because this, I think that, in the meanwhile we will continue listening LRA36 up to the end of this year. May be in the future we can listen LRA36 from Base Marambio or other Argentine Base, if Base Esperanza is closed, according to the journalistic versions. 4606 RRI Serui, Full data prepared card received in 7 weeks for an Indonesian f/up report, audio tape, and mint stamps (used) sent via registered mail from Hungary. This was in response to a March, 2000 reception. There are two v/s on the card. One appears to be Y. Kaisiu, the other is Mika Numberi, Asistem Manajer. This card was mailed as a postcard, and wasn't enclosed in an envelope. I use 67 pound cover stock for printing my own cards, and surprisingly the card survived the long journey without any damage. TARTU PERERAADIO 1035 - RADIO NOVOJA ZHIZN

Jim Hulse, owner and manager for "Towers For Jesus" and at the moment in charge of the transmitter project in Tartu, Estonia (Tartu Pereraadio -Tartu Family Radio) now testing its 50 KW-transmitter with Christian content and relaying a Russian station, tells me in a mail September 27th.: "Last night we made some major repairs on the transmitter and noticed a big improvement in the signal. Could you please give us a report on the signal now after the repairs. I hope it is better. God Bless, Jim Hulse" The email address to Jim Hulse is: 7hulsefm@cbd.net. If you want to look at "his" website it is: <http://www.towersforjesus.org> Jim Hulse also told in an email some days ago: "I am with Towers For Jesus and a missionary who builds Christian radiostations around the world. We built this station in Estonia and are here now finishing up the last details. Thank you so much for sending your report, it is the first one we have gotten. We are not officially on the air yet and are testing and tuning. We have been running 50 KW most of the time and are licensed for 100 KW. We are going on the air with the 50 KW transmitter now and the 100

KW later. We started with a 818 foot tower last year and then a dispute came up on the frequency we were assigned at 612. We decided to change frequency to 1035 and not battle in courts for years. In the process of changing frequency we took off 338 feet of tower and placed it in front of the existing tower and are using it as a director for night time use. This station is mainly concerned with broadcasting to the Russian people the Christian view." - Jan Edh, Hudiksvall, Sweden - DX-ing in Fredriksfors

The website mentioned above tells that the transmitter was donated by Billy Graham's Blue Ridge Broadcasting. Otherwise the site includes mainly photographs without any notes about who is on and what they are doing...

AFGHANISTAN

Today on September 17 I monitored Afghanistan on 7087v in Denmark as follows: 0125 (tune in) - 0245* Domestic service in Pushtu until 0217 when programme in Dari began. Mostly men talking about the Taliban and Osmanabin Laden.

The Voice of Shari'ah drifted from 7089.7 to 7087.6. SINPO34444, but from *0242-0357* **QRM from the Voice of Iraqi Kurdistan**, Iraq on 7090.0 in Arabic (34444).

External service: *1530 English, 1545 Arabic, 1600 Turkmen, 1615 Uzbek, 1630 Urdu, 1650-1710* Russian. The Voice of Shari'ah drifted from 7087.0 to 7086.8. SINPO 22332 with much **QRM from European radioamateurs**. (Anker Petersen, Editor of DSWCI Domestic Broadcasting Survey, Denmark) - HCDX

Afghanistan noted here in Finland, too, on 1107 kHz around 1630-1700Z. Distortious audio but strong signal w some QRM from Egypt. This is seemingly the old Russian built tx but I doubt they are running 1000 kW (Jorma Mantyla, Sept 17) - HCDX

Fiercely monopolistic media conglomerate Clear Channel, which controls an astonishing 1,170 commercial radio stations in the US (plus some 240 elsewhere), has directed its stations to avoid playing a list of some 150 "lyrically questionable" songs. Prominently included in the banned list are ant-war songs such as "Knockin' On Heaven's Door," "Eve of Destruction," "Blowin' in the Wind" and "99 Luftballons."

Here are some of the more, um, interesting choices: The Beatles "Obla Di, Obla Da" U2 "Sunday Bloody Sunday" Peter Paul and Mary "Blowin' in the Wind" Peter Paul and Mary "Leavin' on a Jet Plane" Simon And Garfunkel "Bridge Over Troubled Water" Don McLean "American Pie" John Lennon "Imagine" Frank Sinatra "New York, New York".

CRUSADE

Bush's "crusade" seen as war on Muslims
Text of report by BBC Monitoring research on 19 September:

The US and international media have expressed concern over the word "crusade" used by US President George W. Bush in reference to a possible military strike against the Taleban and prime suspect Usamah Bin-Ladin in Afghanistan. Bush used the word "crusade" on 16 September when addressing US counter-terrorism efforts. "This is a new kind of, a new kind of evil... and the American people are beginning to understand. This crusade, this war on terrorism is going to take awhile." "The word "crusade" in the United States does not have the same religious and historical connotations as in Europe and the Middle East where images are brought to mind of Christian military expeditions to capture the "Holy Land" of Jerusalem from Muslims in the Middle Ages.

The pan-Arabic satellite TV channel Al-Jazeera, which is based in Qatar, responded immediately. The channel's Washington correspondent highlighted Bush's use of the word "crusade" while covering his address live at the White House address. In a subsequent interview with US Secretary of State Powell, Al-Jazeera asked: "Some people were upset when they heard President Bush last Sunday [16 September] describing this war as a crusade campaign." "The following day, a former Lebanese ambassador to Washington, Abdallah Bu-Habib, clarified in a Lebanese TV interview that President Bush did not mean a crusade war but a campaign against terrorism.

Nevertheless, Bush's controversial statement has sparked international criticism. The Libyan news agency Jana, and newspaper commentators in Germany, France, Belgium and elsewhere in Europe have expressed alarm. Germany's Die Tageszeitung newspaper said

the president's use of the word "crusade" revealed hidden motives. "A crusade, historically meaning a missionary campaign of the Christian West: how does that fit with a discourse on the peaceful living side by side of the various religions in the United States, with the build-up of an international coalition against terrorism in which as many Arabic and Muslim states as possible are to join in? It does not fit at all," the paper said. In the Middle East, some media have used the Arabic translation "salibiyah", which specifically refers to the Medieval Christian Crusades, instead of the Arabic word "hamlah", which means a campaign.

The front-page headline of Jordan's weekly Al-Sabil read: "Bush: the crusade campaign [Arabic: al-hamlah salibiyah] has started." The weekly, citing BBC's News Online web site and Al-Jazeera TV, reported Bush's remark as follows: "This crusade campaign, this war against terrorism, will be a long-drawn-out one." Another Jordanian newspaper, Al-Dustur, noted local reaction to Bush's statement. "President George Bush's remarks, disseminated by Arab and world media, in which he described the military campaign against terrorism as a 'crusade war', has triggered angry reactions in Jordan," the daily said. The article cited a number of Jordanian figures as saying that this proves "the war has been turned into a war against Muslims". The Iraqi newspaper Babil, which is owned by President Saddam Husayn's son Uday, reported, erroneously, that the BBC had "tried to polish up President Bush's statement by deleting the word 'crusade'". In Finnish TV, a scholar of ME languages, Prof. Heikki Palva, was very concerned about the word "crusade" which was translated in BBC farsi and uzbek language broadcasts as "holy war against Islamic world".
