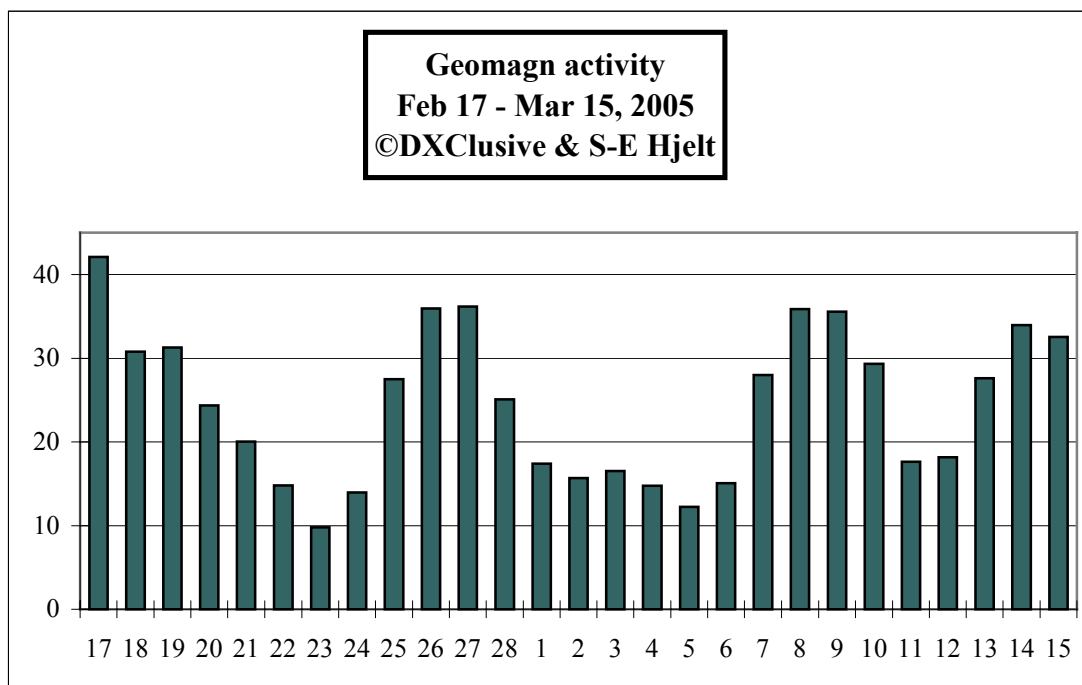

LEM197 – Summary

16.10.2004 – 23.10.2004

Members: POS&MD

Radio equipment: JRC NRD-515, 2 NRD-525s, NRD-535 and NRD-535D.

Antennas: Normal antenna farm plus an experimental Pacific antenna in 30 degrees, which now has become permanent for this DX-cottage.

Special thanks to the members of LEM196, RS and TUA, for excellent job in maintaining the antenna farm, baluns and the coax connections inside the cottage.

Very good reception conditions this time. From the very beginning on 16.10.2004 there were a lot of Hawaiian stations present on the MW band. And it would become even greater. New Zealand came in at around 1400 UTC the same evening. We were lucky to catch local announcements from all the three Newstalk ZB-stations we heard on 1008, 1035 and 1080 kHz. In addition to these stations, the tiny BBC WS relay station on 1476 kHz was heard on two occasions, as tentative on 16.10.2004 and with more stable signals on 19.10.2004 during a very interesting early opening to that area.

Pacific was more present than ever before in the small Lemmenjoki cottage. One explanation might be the very low sunspot numbers, Zero spots was reported on both October 10th and 11th, and the disturbance taken place on October 13th and 14th really opened up the scene. We found new stations from Pacific every day. The area is vast and the reception conditions naturally didn't favour exactly the same area all the time.

Next day, Sunday October 17th favoured Guam and Saipan in the North West, with three stations available, KGUM-567, KTWG-801 and KCNM-1080, the last two stations were simulcasting the same religious program. We could at the same time hear some stations from the Philippines, but not too well. And it was impossible to get any stations from Micronesia despite trying. These stations would probably have needed much better conditions right on target.

Monday, October 18th gave a much wanted Radio Tonga-1017 kHz, which has been heard once before in Finland by Mika Mäkeläinen. And after that we were left with empty hands starting to find new stations. Thanks to good and stable reception conditions, despite weak signals, we were already on this day able to hear V7AD Radio Marshalls-1098 and Samoa-540, the last one without a proper station identification but otherwise with distinct program details. In trying to find new stations, we studied the loggings made by Grayland DX-peditions on the US west coast. We found especially the log made in Summer 1997 very useful and interesting. In general, stations often logged in the Northwest of USA would, we thought, have the best possibility to be heard also in Finland, if just the frequency would be free from other stations.

Tuesday, October 19th was one of the more interesting days. V7AD Radio Marshalls came in with strong signals quite early. Tonga was not as strong as the day before. We knew that AFN Kwajalein-1224 would be active, contrary to the station broadcasting on 1557 kHz. And it was with pleasure we noticed that this station started the journey into our headphones and cassette recorders around 1030 UTC. We thought before our expedition that 10 kW would be needed to get a proper signal through, but this tiny NPR Worldwide relay is broadcasting with only 750 watts from an inverted V on the backyard of the station building at the southernmost part of the Kwajalein atoll. Between 1115-1135 the conditions went down to New Zealand on the higher frequencies and we had the possibility to try for these long distance stations for a while, before the Japanese and the Chinese stations boomed in. We heard Auckland again on 1476 kHz with their BBC WS relay.

Tahiti-738 was checked every day, and also Kiribati-846, but these frequencies were covered by Russian stations, until Wednesday October 20th, when Tahiti came in with a stable signal. Not any signal from New Zealand this day on 1476, but instead there was a station playing non-stop hindi-music on 1467 kHz. Hours of recording gave one tiny top of the hour identification for Radio Fiji, but otherwise only a lot of enjoyable Indian music. 1152 kHz could also be noted but with a weaker signal.

Thursday, October 21st gave the very same stations as Wednesday. Lots of non-stop Indian music again from the 1467 kHz station which could be heard very late. Without the top of the hour identification, we would have taken it for India. After all at 1425 UTC, you would presume that this sort of music belongs to AIR during normal circumstances.

On Friday, October 22nd, we heard the US graveyard stations with good signals so we concentrated our listening to these stations. A check at 1130 UTC gave Radio Marshalls-1098 signing off, but otherwise there were not any signals left from the Pacific. In the afternoon we got an explanation to that. It had been snowing during the night, and the antenna we used for these stations had come down and was broken after 200 meters – even with this tiny antenna it was possible to hear Radio Marshalls. We heard Radio Marshalls-1098 five days in a row. The station has not been heard in Europe before, but we believe it will be heard more often in the future. As a valuable piece of information for other listeners we noticed that parts of the national anthem contains very high music tones, so they just like morse penetrates the airwaves despite huge interference. Maybe the station will be picked up in Bromarv, or Porvoo in the next few years, who knows.

The reception conditions also favoured the whole of the Pacific Rim area from Mexico/California up along the North American coast to Alaska and down to Japan and Northeast of China. We managed to hear many stations from the western USA, especially from California, Oregon, Washington, Nevada, Idaho and Wyoming. The most interesting openings were an early evening opening on October 20th, towards the US East Coast starting around 2100 UTC and reaching the best signals at 2200 UTC, and a corresponding late afternoon opening the following day, on October 21st, between 1300-1400 UTC towards California.

LEM 199 - DX-pedition Lemmenjoelle 31.10.-5.11.2004

Kuuntelemassa: Jyrki Hytönen (JHY, Kannus) ja Markus Salonen (MSA, Kylmäkoski)

Laitteina: AOR AR-7030+ ja Icom IC.R-8500, 2 kpl Sangean ATS909:ä sekä nauhurit, md:t & LEM-antennit

Matkaan lähtiessämme toivoimme rauhallista viikkoa auringossa. Sillä vuoden 2003 Lemmenjoen pediksellä pääsimme tutumaan miltä bandi kuulostaa kun A-indeksi nousee kattoon (A >118). Lapissa bandi on silloin aika hiljainen. Täpärällä oli nytkin, sillä bandin seisauttava häiriö alkoi heti lähtömme jälkeisenä päivänä. Vaikka muutaman edellisviikon jatkunut OS-ihmeputki olikin jo katkennut, kelit eivät sentään aivan maassa olleet. Jenkkejä tosin kuului tökkimällä vain muutamana aamuna eikä kertaakaan yöllä. Lattarakelit pysyivät lähes koko ajan La Platan suunnalla. Idässä signaalit katkesivat linjalle Thaimaa-Intia-Pakistan ja lähempi itä. Kiinan kieltä saimme kuunnella, mutta japanin ja korean kielioppaita ei tarvittu. Hieman vaisuista keleistä huolimatta monia todella mieleenpainuvia nappauksia tehtiin lähempää ja kauempaa idästä ja lännestäkin. Vaikka

heinähamemusiikkia emme kuulleetkaan, emme kuitenkaan olleet täysin pettyneitä viikon keleihin: monipuolisesti asemia eri puolilta. Kaikkea mahdollista kuuntelevina rapoja kummallekin kertyi satakunta.

MSA lähti liikkeelle Hämeestä lauantaiaamuna ja noukki JHY:n Kannuksesta matkaan. Näin vältimme puuduttavan yöajon menettäen tosin yhden iltapäivän kuuntelut. Tilannetta helpotti HAT:in viesti kielten heikkenemisestä.

31.10. Sunnuntai A=10, K = 1-3.

Radiot avattiin noin 0010. Intialaisten aloituksista aloitettiin napaten 0028 UTC muutamit idit (648 AIR Indore, 1287 AIR Panaji ja 1305 AIR Parbhani). Sitten kelit olivatkin jo 0130 alkaen itäisessä Brasiliassa ja La Platan alueella (mm. R Maldonado 1560, R Novas de Paz 1380). Kun lattarit hävisivät 0600 jälkeen tilalle ei noussut yhtäkään jenkkiä. Päivän Oseania odotukset kokivat pettymyksen, yhtäkään varmaan OS MW-asemaa muutama hawaijilaista lukuunottamatta emme koko aikana noteeranneet (toki 4960 vanimolainenkin kelpasi). Iltapäivällä kevyempää Aasia tawaraa, joukossa helmenä Thahaan Akart 1017, myöhemmin lähinnä vain lähi-itäläisiä.

01.11. Maanantai A = 5, K = 1-3

Yöllä pari rupubressaria valvotutti (mm. 760 Uirapuru, 1360 Bandeirantes), mutta vaikka tuhinoita kuunneltiin koko yö kunnon nousua mihinkään suuntaan ei tullut. Aamu (0500-) toi kuuluviin jo muutaman jengin, mutta ei vielä raporttiin asti. Myöhemmin aamulla muutama IB-asema kuului, uutena RNE-5 Castilla Mancha 1314. Aasia avautui 1150 alkaen muutaman Thain noustessa (mm. 1557 RT Trad, Thahaan Akartit 945 ja 1224). Loppupäivä olikin sitten pelkkää intiakuuntelua, helminä Vijaywada 837, Jalgaon 963, Sangli 1251 ja Mathura 1584. Jalgaon kuului ilman tietoakaan YLE:stä, lievänä vaivana vain Xinjiang PBS. Komeiden Jalgoanin lokaalidien mennessä purkkiin 1600 tunti DX-kuuntelullista riemua, taas oli mahdottomalta tuntunut muuttunut todeksi. Thai asemien yönousu alkoi jo 1945 (1296 Kasetsart) ja 2100 noteerattiin 1197 Jor Thor Lor Lopburista sekä useampikin unideiksi jäänyt.



Peditionkettu noteerattiin useana yönä kiertelemässä lem-mökkiä.

02.11. Tiistai A= 4, K = 0-3

Lupaavat indeksit eivät vastanneet alkuunkaan todellisuutta. Kelit olivat täysin poikki. Yöllä taas tavallista La Plataa (mm. 1070 El Mundo, 1410 AM Libre) ja brassaritöhinää ilman kunnon nousua. Kun lattarit katosivat 0600, muuta kuunneltavaa bandille ei kertynyt (ei NA, ei IB). Aasian nousua keskiaalloille ei kuulunut, joten välipaloiksi napattiin alkuiltapäivästä lyhyiltä vietnamilaiset Son La ja Dien Bien Radio. Keskiaalloilla kelit eivät kantaneet kovin hyvin Intiaankaan asti, mutta mukavasti tuli 936 AKR Mirpur lopettaen Azad Kashmir ideihin ja lauluun 1837. Sitten seuraavat maininnanarvoiset olivat klo 20 jälkeen nousseet thait (lopburilainen 1197) ja muutamit kiinalaiset (Guizhou RGD 1026).

03.11. Keskiviikko A = 10, K = 0-4

Brassareita alkoi kuulua jo 2115 alkaen (mm. 1500 Jacuipe, 1260 Morada do Sol, 1360 Universo). Aamuyöstä 0330 lähtien sekaan tuli La Plataa (mm. 840 R Salta, 970 R AM970 Cordoba). Bonuksena tuli vastaan R Resp.

Altay 1350. Myöhemmin 0445 lähtien hyvin Keski-Amerikkaa, Bahama 1540 tuli lopultakin napattua. Aamulla 0600 jälkeen tulikin jo jenkkejäkin enemmän, aluksi NF ja NS asemia. Myöhemmin myös usalaisia, huipentumana 0900 1340:llä idanneet WNBH ja WNZS, vähän aiemmin WNIO 1390. Tämä olikin koko viikon ehdottomasti paras jenkkaaamu. Jenkkien häivyttävä 0930 alkoivatkin aika hyvät aasiakelit. Bandilla oli kiinalaisia (mm. Xining RGD 1476, Yangzhou RGD 1179), filippiiniläisiä (mm. 954, 1179, 1233, ja 1548). Lähempää ilahduttivat mm. AIR Mathura ja Keonjhar 1584 ja R Nepal 792 englanninkielisillä uutisilla, ja AKR Mirpur 936 kuului nytkin. Jokunen thai nousi 1500 jälkeen (828 Kong Thap Thii Saam, 837 RT Bangkok). Illan niukoista iberialaisista mukavin oli COPE Badajoz 1296.

04.11. Torstai A = 7, K = 2-3

Yö noudatti vanhaa kaavaa, brassareita/laplatalaisia, parhaana 1520 Chacosomús. Aamulla mm. jenkkejä, meksikolaisia ja Venezuelaa, asemat kuitenkin pääosin vanhoja tuttuja. Vaan vielä oli edessä viikon parhaat kelihetket. Noin 0800-1000 olleen pienen suvantovaiheen jälkeen löytyi kuunneltavaa sen minkä ehti. Jotain merkkejä oseanialaisistakin, kaikki jäivät kuitenkin tentatiivisiksi (havaijilaisista mm. 1420, 1460 ja 1500 kuuluivat hyvin). Jenkeistä napattiin mm. KSRO 1350 ja KLKI 1340. Taajuudella 1470 tuli hetken erittäin lujaa XERCN ja 1480 kuului unid XEBBB idejä antanut asema. Kun asemat lännestä alkoivat olla tavallisimpia länsirannikkoasemia, oli vaihdettava antennejä ja siirryttävä itään, jossa vallalla oli Kiina (mm. kiinalaiset Xilingol RGD 1395 ja Hinggan RGD 891 kuuluivat hyvin).

05.11. Perjantai A=5, K = 0-2

Indeksit lupasivat hyvää, kelit sen sijaan heikot. Yö oli lattareiden suhteen hieman heikompi. Aamulla kuitenkin nousi joitain kuubalaisia, tavallisia idän jenkkejä (1080 WTIC, 1360 WDRC) ja venezuelalaisia. Iltapäivä oli kaukoidän suuntaan tukossa eikä thaimaalaisistakaan paljoa irronnut (1404 Thor Phor Neung, Suphanburi). Kelit eivät enää kantaneet kunnolla Intiaan, mutta vastapainoksi hieman lähempää noteerattiin mukavia asemia, mm. 567 RP Khuzdar, 792 AKR Muzaffarabad, 1197 BBC Astana, 936 AKR Mirpur ja 1602 uusi afgaani R Khost.

06.11. Lauantai A = 3, K = 0-2

Yön kelit olivat tällä kertaa Venezuelassa (970 Mundial Oriente, 1300 R 1300, 1370 Pascua), eikä enää La Platan suunnalla. Ecuadorista Teleradio AM 1350 ilahdutti kuulumalla ihan mukavasti. Muutama jenkkinä kävi bandilla ennen kuin töpselit ja antennit irrotettiin. Ajoitus oli sopiva, sillä myrsky saapui ja seuraava porukka saikin kärvistellä hirmumyrskyn kourissa.

Sää oli suotuista, pientä pakkasta, jos sitäkään. Lunta niukasti. Mukava oli antennimetsässä astella. Reissusta jäi positiivinen saldo. Lokissa on lihavoitu omalta mututuntumalta parhaiksi arveltuja asemia.

Radio 538 says it now plays too many current hit singles, and maintains that this breaches the terms of its licence. The Commission for the Media has already said it will investigate if the format change complies with the media law. Michel de Winter of ID&T says that the station has no intention of changing its format again to suit Radio 538. For its part, Radio 538 says it will go to court if ID&T does not respond within five working days.

RNE explained that from now on digital and analogue transmissions will share the same frequency, "until we migrate definitively to digital technology, giving the capacity for a greater number of quality programmes on mediumwave, similar to FM, with additional multimedia services and the possibility of automatic tuning." According to RNE the innovative character of digital

Afghan Women's Voice Radio will restart broadcasting tomorrow, Tuesday [18 January]. A report by the UNAMA office in Kabul says that it seems that the Afghan mass media will have a stronger and brighter future. The Afghan Women's Voice Radio restarts its broadcast tomorrow, Tuesday, from the Cultural Centre which is managed by a non-government organization, IIMI, in Kabul.

The radio programmes will be launched by the country's president tomorrow. The inauguration will be broadcast live at 1015 hours [local time]. The radio programmes will cover Kabul, Parwan [province north of Kabul], Logar [south of Kabul], Maidan Wardag [west of Kabul] and [eastern] Nangarhar Province on AM 69.3 {sic} [kHz] from 0600 hours [local time] until 2000 hours. The 11 female reporters of the radio station and technical workers will not only cover issues of health, education, women's rights, and informative programmes on family crisis, but will also fight sensitive issues such as divorce and forced engagements.

KAUAI-based Hochman-McCann Hawaii Inc. has purchased the license to build a 19th Honolulu AM radio station. Partners George Hochman and Oahu-based Byron McCann bought the construction permit for KRUD-AM 1130 from Memphis-based broadcaster George S. Flinn Jr. for \$60,000, according to documents filed with the Federal Communications Commission.

The FCC has approved the transfer of the broadcast license and the financial part of the deal will close soon, Hochman said. "We're going to put it on, hopefully by summertime, but we've got to build it," said Hochman. The studios will share space with Honolulu sister-station KORL-AM 690. Separately, Hochman owns Kauai's KITH-FM 98.9 and KTOH-FM 99.9 and Maui's KONI-FM 104.7.

Hochman-McCann paid \$550,000 for KORL in 2003. The station carries multicultural programming provided by individuals and businesses that purchase blocks of air time. "It's kind of like old-time radio. There's no formula, no 'gotta be No. 1 (mentality).' They just super-serve their communities and we get really good response," Hochman said.

KORL carries primarily Japanese, Filipino, Chinese and some Spanish-language programming. Hochman plans a similar format for the new station, which will not be seen as serious competition by Honolulu's larger radio operators.

"I'm not going to be silly enough to try to compete on a little 500-watt AM station," he said. "I don't think we're going to be knocking off Perry and Price."

One of his first orders of business will be to request a call letter change from the FCC. "If I had a sports station I'd probably keep 'em," as

sort of a tongue-in-cheek, fun handle, "but no, I don't want to be known as 'cruddy radio'," he said (via Andy Sennitt, dxldyg via DXLD)

VANUATU: Radio Vanuatu set to improve shortwave service The tsunami disaster has spurred at least one country to put its national broadcasting service in order. In the Pacific state of Vanuatu, only half the population can hear the national broadcasting service, because the shortwave transmitter was allowed to fall into disrepair some years ago. The transmitter is still in operation, but apparently at reduced power. But now, reports The Independent, at the insistence of the country's Prime Minister they're frantically working to get 7260 kHz – the daytime frequency -working again properly.

After that, the nighttime frequency of 3945 kHz will also be put back on full power as quickly as possible. The renovation has been made possible with financial assistance from the New Zealand Government and Radio Australia. After the shortwave service is fixed, it will be the turn of the mediumwave transmitters in Santo and Vila, which will have to be sent to Australia to be examined by technicians to get an idea how much they will cost to repair. The TV service in Vanuatu is also going to be improved. (Sennitt via HCDX Feb 3)
