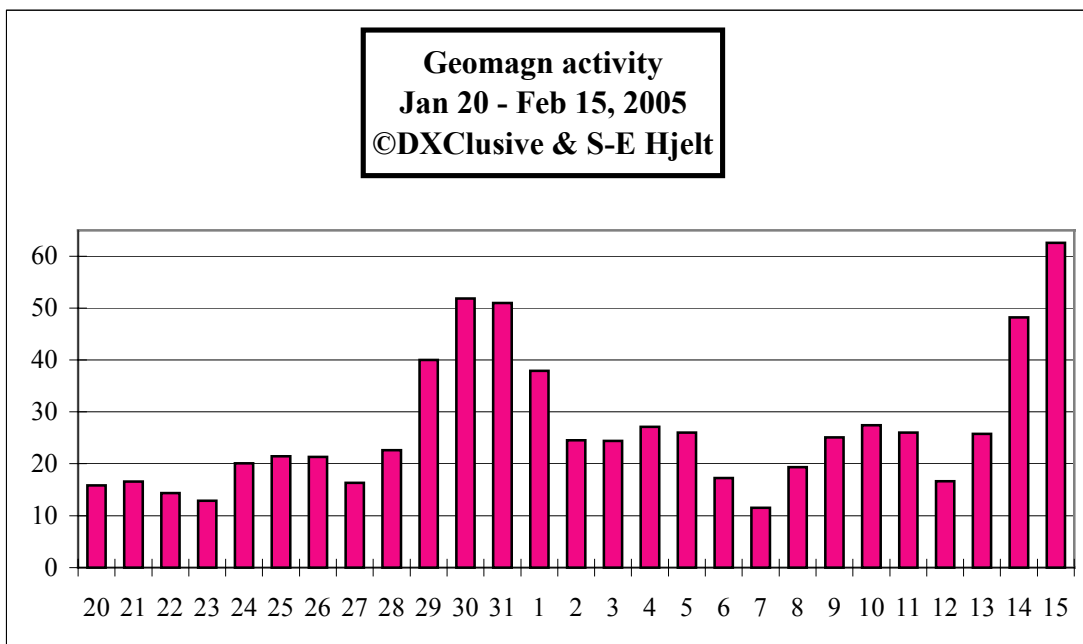

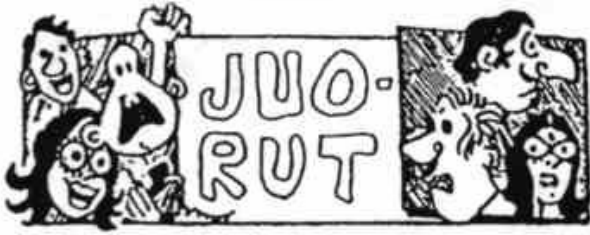

However, VIVA-Radio never saw the light of the day; finally the licence has been returned, the frequencies were put on tender again and Truckradio got them. The schedule remains the same (all VOA): 1100-1200 Mandarin, 1200-1230 English; *1230-1300 break*; 1300-1500 Cantonese, 1500-1600 Vietnamese, 1600-1700 (MF) English. The beam is at 332 degrees. (Bernd Trutenau-LTU, mwdx Jan 1 via Topnews)

SAUDI ARABIA: (Text of report in English by Saudi News Agency SPA) Jedda, 5 January: Saudi Arabia's Pilgrimage Enlightenment Radio (PER) will launch its seasonal pilgrimage broadcasting on Monday [10 January], the first day of Dhul-Qi'dah [12 or 13 December 2004], and will continue until the end of the month of Dhul-Hijjah 1425 [9 or 10 February].

The programmes will be broadcast in 10 languages Arabic, English, French, Persian, Turkish, Hausa, Indonesian, Urdu, Bengali and

Pashto. The programmes will be aired 24 hours a day.

Bengali and Pashto have been added for the first time this year in keeping with the efforts of Ministry of Culture and Information to broaden its base of listeners, officials said.

PER will transmit its programmes on two medium wave [frequencies] on 594 kHz for the listeners in Mecca, the pilgrimage sites and Jedda. The other is on 1017 kHz for its listeners in Medina and its vicinity. It also transmits on two FM waves [frequencies] on 94 MHz for the entire area covering the Holy Sites and on 101 MHz for Mina and its vicinity. (DXLD)

TAIWAN: Multilingual "Voice of Taiwan" radio network to be set up. The government is planning to integrate the resources of the two state-owned radio stations to set up a multilingual "Voice of Taiwan" radio network to serve foreign nationals in Taiwan, the Government Information Office director-general said Saturday. Lin Chia-lung unveiled the plan while addressing a Mandarin and Taiwanese story-telling competition for foreigners hosted by the state-owned Radio Taiwan International (RTI). Lin pointed out that the RTI, which receives NT\$500 million (US\$15.6 million) in government funding every year, is mainly responsible for overseas broadcasting. To serve foreign nationals residing in Taiwan and help them better understand the island, the government will set up a new radio network by combining the resources of the RTI and the other state-owned radio station, Voice of Han Broadcasting Network, Lin said. The "Voice of Taiwan" will broadcast programs in a number of different languages, including Mandarin, Taiwanese, English and Japanese, he said. (2004-11-27 19:57:10 Taipei, Nov. 27, CNA, by Y.F. 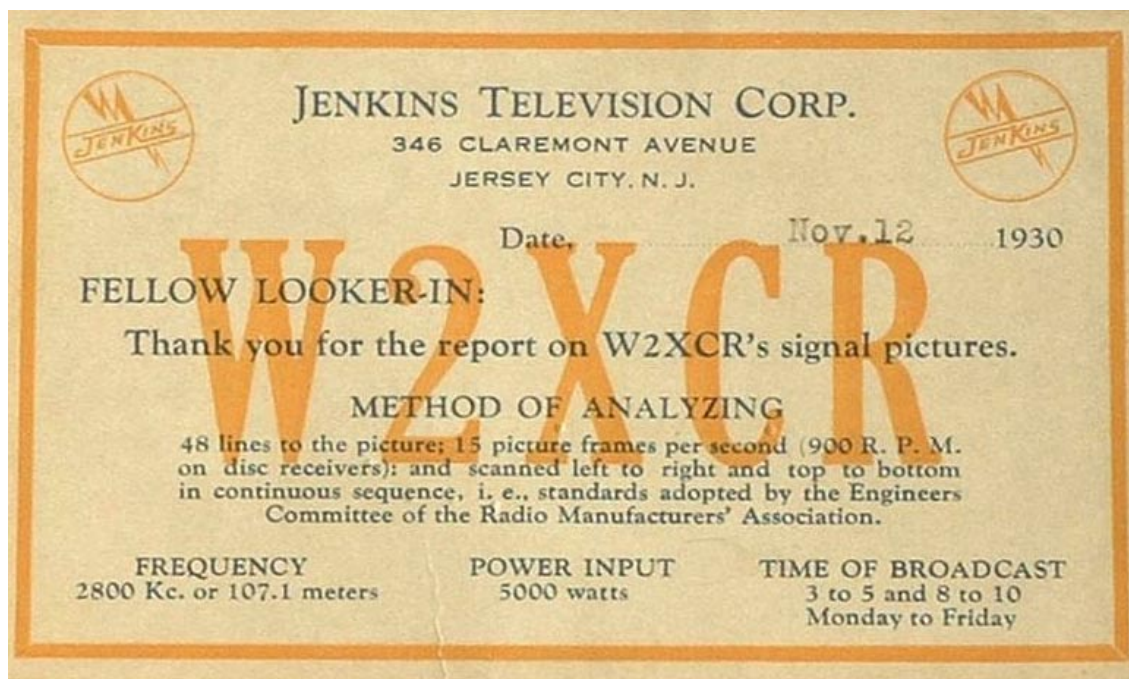
